DESIGN REQUIREMENTS

Traits of a successful medication management system

- Helps user take the correct medication, at the correct time of day, in the correct dosage
- 2. Easily adapts to changes in medication type, routine, and user preferences
- 3. Has a simple interface that is easy to learn
- 4. Facilitates communication between doctors, patients, and caregivers
- 5. Promotes patient independence while slowing caregiver burnout
- 6. Provides persistent reminders but is not intrusive
- 7. Provides instructions for taking medication and what to do in the event of a user or system error
- 8. Integrates with the user's existing habits and routines
- 9. Emphasizes accessibility (adheres to standard accessibility guidelines)
- 10. Keeps medication and medical information secure from unauthorized users
